ATTENTION TAXPAYERS THE DEADLINE TO PAY YOUR 2016 PROPERTY TAXES IS DRAWING NEAR

The deadline to pay your 2016 property taxes is drawing near! Property owners must pay their taxes in full on or before Tuesday, January 31, 2017, in order not to accrue penalties and interest.

The 2016 property taxes are considered delinquent on Wednesday, February 1st, 2017. Penalties and interest will accrue monthly at the following rates: February (7%), March (9%), April (11%), May (13%), June (15%) and July (18%). In addition, "attorney collection fees" will be added to your tax bill if the 2016 property taxes are not paid on or before, Friday, June 30, 2017. Keep in mind that if you mail your tax payments, they will be processed according to the U.S. Post Office "postmark date". Pursuant to Texas Property Tax Code, Tax Assessor/Collector's cannot waive penalty and interest fees on delinquent taxes.
