

Remember to Render! Taxable Property Rendition Forms are due April 1

DOES THIS APPLY TO YOU?

If you own a business and tangible personal property that is used to produce income, such as equipment or inventory, it does!

WHAT IS A RENDITION?

A rendition is a report that lists all of the taxable property that you owned or controlled on January 1st of this year. This often applies to furniture, fixtures, equipment or inventory owned by a business.

WHEN IS THE DEADLINE?

- The last day for filing 2019 renditions is April 1st
- An automatic extension is available if requested in writing on or before the April 1st deadline
- The Chief Appraiser may grant an additional 15 days after the extension request for an owner who shows good cause in writing.

ATTENTION BUSINESS OWNERS!

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO FILE A RENDITION; FAILURE TO FILE BY THE GIVEN DEADLINE WILL RESULT IN A 10% PENALTY.
