

# Remember to Render! Taxable Property Rendition Forms are due April 15.

## DOES THIS APPLY TO YOU?

If you own a business and tangible personal property that is used to produce income, such as equipment or inventory, it does!

## WHAT IS A RENDITION?

It is a report that lists all of the taxable property that you owned or controlled on January 1st of this year. This often applies to furniture, fixtures, equipment or inventory owned by a business.

## WHEN IS THE DEADLINE?

- The last day for filing 2020 renditions is **April 15**.
- An extension is available if requested in writing on or before the April 15 deadline.
- The Chief Appraiser may grant an additional 15 days after the deadline for an owner who shows good cause in writing.

## **ATTENTION BUSINESS OWNERS! IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO FILE A RENDITION.**

Failure to file a rendition by the given deadline will result in a 10% penalty.
